IMPORTANT CHANGES: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

The way the Township manages waste has been in a state of change that will continue into 2010. Previous newsletters provided more detail on the rationale for the changes that are now in effect. Briefly, these changes have been made to meet Ministry of Environment regulations/legislation, divert more waste from landfill, reduce transportation costs and eliminate abuse.

Manned Sites /Limited Hours

As of June 1st, 2010 all of the Township's Transfer Stations will be manned and access will be limited to the Hours of Operation noted below.

Waste Disposal Pass - Garbage Card Mandatory

It is now mandatory that users present a Waste Disposal Pass (Garbage Card) to the Attendant prior to using the Township Waste Disposal Facilities. **Lost or didn't get a pass? Call Public Works @ 705-746-4243 Ext 311.**

Clear Bags Mandatory

It is now mandatory that users bringing bagged household garbage or recyclables to Township Waste Disposal Facilities use only clear plastic bags. Open recycling containers are also acceptable.

ENFORCEMENT

The Township By-law Office will be patrolling the Waste Facilities and issuing tickets to anyone found contravening the Waste By-law. Fines start at \$300.00 and increase based on severity and repeat offences. Please report any abuse by calling 705-746-4243 Ext 311

WASTE DIVERSION

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) – Please take your HHW waste to the MacFarlane depot site in Parry Sound located on MacFarlane Street. **Remember your Waste Disposal Pass. It is open from April 12th to October 17th on the following days: Mon, Wed & Fri., 7:30am – 4:30pm, Sat., 8:00am – 4:00pm & Sun., 12:00pm – 8:00pm. You may also take your household garbage and recyclables to this location.** For additional information call Town of Parry Sound Operations @ 746-2101 X 13

Re-use Material – Re-use centers will be provided at Site 9 Landfill and Healey Lake, Crane Lake, Sheep Head and Devils Elbow Transfer Stations from June to September. Material must be approved by the Attendant before being deposited and is free for anyone to pickup.

WASTE DIVERSION (Cont'd)

Electronic Waste – Facilities to collect (and divert from waste stream) computers, computer monitors and televisions are available at Site 9 Landfill Site, Healey Lake, Crane Lake, Sheep Head Bay and Devils Elbow Transfer Stations from June to September.

Used Tires – Most used tires can now be disposed of at Site 9 Landfill, Healey Lake, Crane Lake & Woods Bay Transfer Stations free of charge.

TWELVE MILE BAY ROAD WASTE TRANSFER SITE

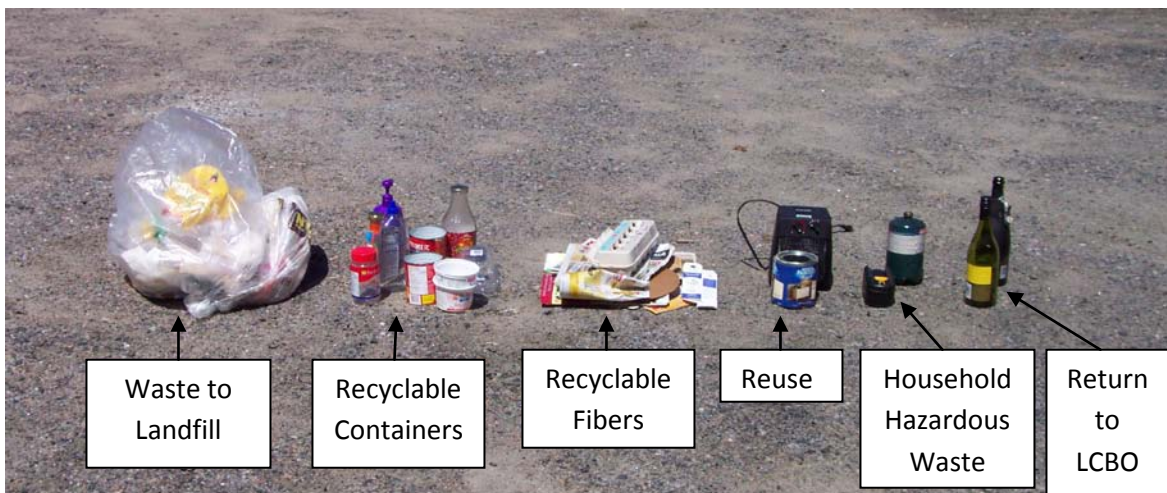

The Archipelago will endeavor to have a formal agreement in place shortly. In the interim, Residents of the Township of The Archipelago using the site have the District's acceptance.
